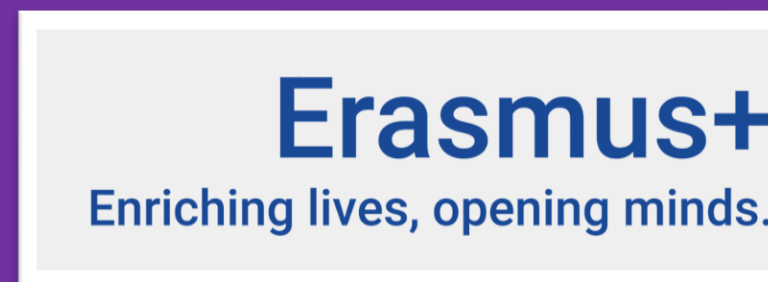

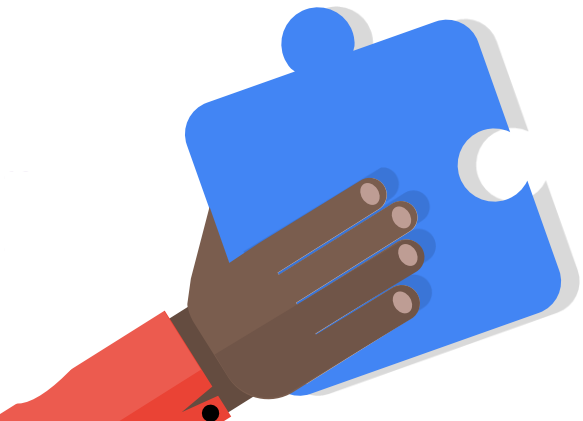
EFFECTIVE WAYS TO ADDRESS CONFRONTATIONS IN THE SCHOOL YARD

What can a student council do?

Why do students quarrel ?

They quarrel to:

- deal with their peers or older children
- because of different emotional states
- because their survival instincts are activated
- To impose their ideas on others



EFFECTIVE WAYS TO ADDRESS CONFRONTATIONS IN THE SCHOOLYARD

What should schools do?

Schools should:

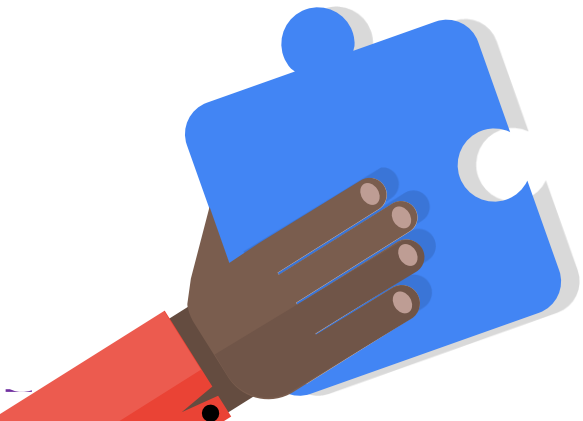
- Organize seminars, to talk about feelings
- Call an expert to talk to the students.
- Have more teachers supervising the students during the break
- Organize workshops about anti-violence and ice breaking



EFFECTIVE WAYS TO ADDRESS CONFRONTATIONS IN THE SCHOOLYARD

What can teachers do?

- They should be stricter to avoid fights.
- Punish those involved



EFFECTIVE WAYS TO ADDRESS CONFRONTATIONS IN THE SCHOOLYARD

What can I do?

- Speak with the students to solve the problem
- Report it to the headmaster
- Solve it by having a student communities gathering
- Talk to the psychologist if anger issues are concerned
- Try to stop them from fighting and report it to the teachers



EFFECTIVE WAYS TO ADDRESS CONFRONTATIONS IN THE SCHOOLYARD

What can the students themselves do?

- Anyone can report their problems to the school council
- They must avoid arguing with other children
- Respect different opinion and find other ways to express their feelings
- They must understand that arguments are not useful anywhere
- They must learn to follow the school rules



Welcoming New Students

Children from other countries, refugees, first-graders

- Reception and integration of children with a migrant background is very important
- Education is an inalienable right, which we must ensure that everyone enjoys
- The aim of the school is to integrate students smoothly into the school environment



WELCOMING NEW PUPILS

What can the school do?

- Teach them the language
- Explain to them how the school system works
- Organize school integration activities
- Organize cultural activities
- Not force them to change their culture and mindset



WELCOMING NEW PUPILS

What can students do?

- Organize welcome parties, in order to get to know each other and fit in groups
- Play games and do special activities, to “break the ice” and make them feel comfortable and safe
- Have a tour in the school, in order to be comfortable and see the school facilities
- Help them adjust in the new school environment



WELCOMING NEW PUPILS

What can students do?

- Keep in touch after school to get to know each other in a better way and strengthen their bonds
- Show them around the city for example museums and monuments
- Show them and inform them about the history and culture of our city
- Make them feel confident, safe and happy in the new environment
- If we see a new student alone, we ought to make him/her feel comfortable, by becoming their friends
