




EVALUATION OF THE MEETING IN GREECE (23-29 JANUARY 2023)


QUESTIONNAIRE FOR STUDENTS

1. How do you evaluate the international cooperation among students taking part in the project?



We notice that 79% of the students believe that the cooperation was very good, 17% good and only 4% poor.

2. How do you evaluate the help of teachers from your school regarding the project?



52% evaluate the help of the teachers very good, 46% good and 1% poor.

91% of the students believe that the communication between the participants was good and only 9% are not very sure about it


3a. If not, say why?

4. Where there any difficulties during the visit?




90% of the students believe that there were not difficulties during the visit, while 10% believe that there were some difficulties.

80% of the students say that they would prefer to stay in hotel and only 20 % would prefer to stay with families.




7. Has your self-confidence increased thanks to the project?



75% of the students believe they have increased their self confidence thanks to the project, 15% are not sure, while 10% says no.

95% of the students are satisfied with the knowledge they gained from the project, while 5% are not




9. Did the project help you improve your IT skills?



54% of the students believe that the program helped them to improve their IT skills, while 46% says no.

10. Did you find any differences in the function of student communities? If yes mention the differences.




82% of the students said that they found differences in the function of student communities.

The differences are:

- 1. In Greece schools have a 15-member School Council and 5-members student communities
- 2. In Germany schools have a 12-member School Council from all around the school and each class has 2 representatives (one boy and one girl).
- 3. The Germans have a different kind of student communities (student representatives) and although the number of students in the school is much bigger (800 students) than those in Greece (170 students), the student council 12-member, less than Greece (15- member)
- 4. The school culture in Germany
- 5. In Germany the School Council has money
- 6. In Germany have some different subjects
- 7. In Germany students vote in the student council for someone to go to another country, while in Greece students in order to visit another country are chosen on behavior

- 11. Did the program help you realize if the school's function democratically?








77% of the students were helped to realize if the schools, function democratically, while 23% were not helped.
